ITEM 16 - AUTHORIZATION TO AMEND THE ERIE COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY'S ANNUAL O & M BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008

WHEREAS, In a resolution dated November 30, 2007 the Erie County Water Authority (the "Authority") adopted its Annual Budget for the fiscal year 2008; and

WHEREAS, From time to time, due to changes in spending priorities, availability of

funds, or changes in other circumstances the Authority finds it proper to amend its Budget to reflect such changes; and

WHEREAS, The Authority's 2008 Budget contains a new position of Diesel Mechanic & an additional position of Pump Mechanic. The annual wage for these positions was estimated to be, at budget preparation time, \$45,115. There is also one occupied position of Pump Mechanic; and

WHEREAS, After conducting interviews, and a review of the job duties of Diesel Mechanic and Pump Mechanic, it was determined that the proper placement of these positions should be in Grade 7A of the Blue-Collar Hourly Pay Grades contained in the current Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Authority and AFSCME Local 930, which position has a starting wage of \$48,485; and

WHEREAS, The Authority desires to amend the 2008 Annual Budget by the placement of the positions of Diesel Mechanic and Pump Mechanic into Blue-Collar Hourly Pay Grade 7A, as described above, and by increasing the starting wage of said position, accordingly, from \$45,115 per annum, to \$48,485 per annum, resulting in amending the O&M budget as follows:

WHEREAS, In 2004 GASB issued Statement No. 45, *Accounting and Financial Reporting for Post Employment Benefits Other Than Pensions;* and

WHEREAS, Based upon the Erie County Water Authority's ("Authority") level of revenues, adoption of GASB Statement No. 45 is required beginning in years starting after December 15, 2007; and

WHEREAS, The Authority has retained an actuarial firm to perform a valuation of the Authority's post retirement benefits; and

WHEREAS, The Authority has the option to elect to adopt GASB Statement No.45 for a fiscal year prior to the required year of adoption; and,

WHEREAS, The Audit Committee of the Board of Commissioners finds that since the Authority is aware of it's obligations as determined by the actuarial valuation, that it is prudent to early adopt GASB Statement No.45; and

WHEREAS, The Audit Committee of the Board of Commissioners has reported on it's findings from the committee meeting of January 10, 2008 to discuss this and other issues impacting the Authority;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Erie County Water Authority elects to adopt GASB Statement No.45, *Accounting and Financial Reporting for Post Employment Benefits Other Than Pensions*, for its fiscal year ending December 31, 2007 and hereby directs that the appropriate entries be made on the Authority's financial records.
