WHEREAS, The RFP for Employee Assistance Program services will be conducted pursuant to the newly enacted legislation, New York State Finance Law §§ 139-j and 139-k and the Authority's Purchasing Guidelines, Policies and Procedures; and

**WHEREAS,** Matthew J. Baudo, Secretary to the Authority, will be the designated contact person for the RFP with the adoption of this resolution;
