PURPOSE

To provide a comprehensive and competitive program of employee insurance benefits.

POLICY

It is the policy of the Authority to make available to active Managerial and Confidential employees, insurance benefits designed to safeguard the health of Authority employees and their families, provide income replacement to employees in the event of loss of regular earnings due to long-term disability, and provide a level of financial protection to families in the event of the death of an employee. The benefit descriptions contained herein are intended as a summary only. The official terms of the Authority's insurance plans are contained in plan documents.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

- Newly hired employees shall first become eligible for either single or family coverage on the
 first of the month following their date of active employment.
- Effective June 1, 2004, the Authority shall provide as its insurance plan a traditional point of service (POS) type contract which shall be provided by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Western New York through the Labor/Management Health Coalition, Inc. (LMHC).
- 3. Employees will have the option of participating in the Core Plan, the Enhanced Plan or the Value Plan. Effective January 1, 2011 the Authority shall pay eight-five (85%) percent of the cost of the Core Plan for single and family coverage. The Employee shall contribute fifteen (15%) percent of the monthly premium cost of the Core Plan through payroll deduction.

Page 1 of 4

- For those employees that elect to enroll in the Enhanced Plan, the employee shall be required to pay the difference in cost between the Enhanced Plan and the Authority's share of the Core Plan.
- 5. For those employees that enroll in the Value Plan, the Authority shall pay eighty-five (85%) percent of the cost of the Value Plan for single and family coverage. The Employee shall contribute fifteen (15%) of the monthly premium cost of the Value Plan through payroll deduction. The Authority shall deposit fifty (50%) percent of the difference in the monthly premium cost between the Core Plan and the Value Plan in an IRS Section 105-H account. Monies deposited in such account shall roll over year to year until expended, or until employee's death, at which time any unexpended funds shall revert to the Authority.

DENTAL INSURANCE

- Newly hired employees shall become eligible for either single or family coverage on the first
 of the month following their date of active employment.
- Coverage is provided through the Preferred Dental Plan. The plan is administered by Group Health Incorporated (GHI). Benefits shall include 100% Prosthetic Allowance and Orthodontia for dependent children to age twenty-three.
- The Authority shall contribute toward the premium an amount up to \$27.43 per month for single coverage or \$109.70 per month for family coverage. Any excess cost shall be borne by the employee through an authorized payroll deduction.

VISION CARE PLAN

- Newly hired employees shall become eligible for either single or family coverage on the first
 of the month following their date of active employment.
- Coverage is provided through the Vision Service Plan (VSP). The plan includes benefits for vision examinations, lenses, frames and contact lenses.
- 3. The Authority shall pay the full premium for either single or family coverage.

SHORT-TERM DISABILITY

1. Newly hired employees shall be enrolled on the first of the month following one month of active employment.

- 2. Benefits begin on the eighth day of injury/sickness, and may continue for a maximum benefit period of 26 weeks at fifty-percent of an employee's weekly earnings to a maximum of \$1,000 per week less other income benefits. Benefit payments and duration are subject to the conditions of the Plan.
- 3. Short Term Disability Benefits will not be paid for an occupational injury or sickness.
- 4. The full cost of this plan shall be borne by the Authority.

LONG-TERM DISABILITY

- Newly hired employees shall be enrolled on the first of the month following their date of active employment.
- Benefits begin following 180 days of disability and equal 70% of an employee's basic monthly earnings up to \$5,000, less other income benefits. Benefit payments and duration are subject to the conditions of the Plan.
- 3. The full cost of this plan shall be borne by the Authority.

LIFE INSURANCE

- 1. Authority paid coverage provides employee life insurance and accidental death and dismemberment benefits through the following group plans:
 - A. Newly hired employees shall be enrolled in the life insurance plan on the first of the month following their date of hire.
 - B. Newly hired employees shall be enrolled in an additional life insurance plan provided by the carrier on the first of the month following their initial 26 weeks of active employment.
- In addition, the Authority may from time to time offer employees the opportunity to participate in optional life insurance programs on a contributory basis.

MEDICAL AND/OR DENTAL INSURANCE WAIVER

Employees who are covered under an alternate plan may elect cash payments in lieu of Authority provided medical and/or dental insurance coverage. The Medical/Dental Insurance Waiver is further explained in Policy No. 44.0.

RETIREE MEDICAL INSURANCE

Eligible employees who retire after April 1, 1991 shall be provided with single or family medical insurance. Retiree Medical Insurance is explained further in Policy No. 46.0.

COBRA CONTINUATION BENEFITS

Employees and/or their eligible dependents shall be provided the opportunity to continue their medical, dental and/or vision coverage under COBRA should their Authority provided coverage terminate. COBRA is explained further in Policy No. 45.0.

PURPOSE

To describe the conditions under which the Authority may extend medical insurance coverage to eligible retirees.

POLICY

It is the policy of the Authority to provide medical insurance coverage to employees who retire after April 1, 1991, and who, at the time of retirement, satisfy the age and service requirements defined in this policy.

PROCEDURE

- Eligibility is extended to employees who retire after April 1, 1991, and who, at the time of retirement, have met one of the following age and employment service requirements:
 - A. At least fifty-five (55) years of age and a minimum of fifteen (15) years service with the Authority; or
 - B. A minimum of ten years service, and a combination of age and service years the sum of which equals at least seventy (70).

ELIGIBILITY

Effective June 1, 2004, the Authority shall provide a retiree, who meets the above age and service eligibility, with a single or family traditional point of service (POS) type contract which shall be provided by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Western New York (BCBSWNY) through the Labor Management Health Care Fund, Inc. (LMHF).

RETIREE CONTRIBUTIONS

Effective for employees who retire on or after April 1, 2012 the Authority shall pay 85% of the full single, double or family premium on behalf of those retirees enrolled in the point of service contract (POS).

The value of an employee's remaining unused sick leave days, computed at his/her regular rate of pay at the time of his/her retirement, may only be used to offset an eligible retiree's share of the monthly premium rates during retirement. A retiree's surviving spouse shall be allowed to use any unused balance of the value of an employee's remaining sick leave days to pay the surviving spouse's share of the monthly premium rates during retirement. The actual number of unused sick leave days at the time of retirement shall be reported to the Retirement System for purposes of section 41 j of the Retirement and Social Security Law.

Upon depletion of the value of any such cash equivalent of sick leave credit, it shall be the retiree's responsibility to pay to the Authority the retiree's share of the health insurance benefits on a monthly basis.

If the retiree elects to relocate to a geographic area outside the point of service contract (POS) service area, the retiree may enroll in the preferred provider organization contract (PPO), but the retiree shall be required to pay the difference between the Authority's share of the POS premium and the PPO premium.

AGE OF MEDICARE ELIGIBILITY

When the retiree or spouse of the retiree has reached 65 years of age or the age of Medicare eligibility, and is eligible for Medicare, each retiree and his/her spouse is required to apply for Medicare Part B coverage when eligible. Individuals who retire after reaching age 65 or the age of Medicare eligibility, must apply for Medicare Part B during the next Medicare Open Enrollment period, January 1 through March 31 of each calendar year.

Application to Medicare by the retiree and his/her spouse is a condition of continued Authority provided coverage under this policy.

The cost of Medicare Part B premium shall be borne by the retiree and the retiree's spouse.

At age 65, a Sr. Medicare + Choice insurance product will be substituted. Effective for employees who retire on or after April 1, 2012, the retiree will pay 15% of the premium. Additionally, the retiree may select coverage under a non Medicare PPO; however, the retiree must pay the difference in the Authority's cost between that plan and the highest cost Sr. product plus the 15% cost of the Sr. Medicare + Choice premium.

WAIVER

Retirees who are covered under an alternate plan may elect cash payments in lieu of medical insurance coverage provided through the Authority. The Waiver is further explained in Policy No. 44.A.

RELOCATION OUT OF SERVICE AREA

If the retiree elects to relocate to a different geographic area and no longer wishes to retain coverage as set forth above, the retiree may elect to enroll in a health plan in that area. The Authority will be responsible for the payment equal to 85% of the cost of highest cost product available to the retiree as set forth above.

If the retiree resides outside the service area of plans set forth above, the retiree may submit to the Authority proof of payment to a Health Care provider and the Authority will reimburse the retiree the cost of the annual premium not to exceed the Authority's share of the cost of the highest cost product available to the retirees as set forth above.

SURVIVING SPOUSE

In the event of a retiree's death, coverage will be continued for his or her spouse until he or she dies or remarries under the same terms and conditions as set forth in this policy.

CHANGES

Any changes in the Authority's medical insurance program affecting active employees will also apply equally to retirees or their surviving spouse. Changes may include, but are <u>NOT</u> limited to, summary plan descriptions (SPDs), types or numbers of insurance carrier(s), amount of the Authority's contribution, and plan deductibles or prescription co-pays.

In addition, the Authority may at any time amend or discontinue its policy of providing medical insurance to current and/or future retirees.

A retiree or spouse as indicated in (6) above, shall have the opportunity to change their medical coverage during the annual "open" enrollment period.

LEAD LAYER UMBRELLA COVERAGE (\$10,000,000) (Arch Insurance Co. through Lawley Service Insurance);

PUBLIC OFFICIALS LIABILITY (RSUI through First Niagara Risk Management); OWNERS PROTECTIVE LIABILITY for NYSDOT & NYSDEC (Arch Insurance Co. through Lawley Service Insurance);

DEPEW STREET OPENING BOND (Arch Insurance Co. through Lawley Service Insurance); and

CRIME - COVERAGE FOR FORGERY, THEFT, DISHONESTY, ALTERATION, ETC. INCLUDING PUBLIC OFFICIAL BOND FOR TREASURER & BILL COLLECTOR (Travelers Insurance through Lawley Service Insurance); and

WHEREAS, At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners held on June 27, 2013 the above coverages were placed through the above-named carriers and brokers; and

WHEREAS, It is the recommendation of Authority staff that the coverages outlined above be renewed with the same carriers and brokers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the coverage recommendations for the types of insurance set forth in the body of this resolution be approved and that staff is authorized to bind coverage as identified in this resolution, and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute any and all applications, agreements, forms, etc., to effectuate coverage; and be it further

RESOLVED: That upon receipt, invoices from Lawley Service Insurance and First Niagara Risk Management for subject coverages, be referred to the Comptroller's Office for verification, and if found to be in order, that said invoices be approved and the Treasurer, or in his absence, the Assistant Treasurer, is hereby authorized to pay the same.
