WHEREAS, Said contractor has submitted Change Order No. 1 in the sum of \$142,732.25 to provide for the following changes:

- 1. A 90-day time extension to the Substantial Completion and Final Completion dates
- 2. Additional Rate-of-Change, VFD surge requirement, site to site interlocks and Guenther pump start/stop controls information was added to the contract that was identified by ECWA as a requirement for automation of the system
- 3. ECWA requested that three additional alarms from the new mGuard routers be added to the system
- 4. ECWA identified that the existing chlorine analyzers will be replaced with a Hach WDMP unit and the six additional signals be monitored by SCADA
- 5. ECWA have requested additional Hach WDMP units will be installed at various locations and the seven additional signals be monitored by SCADA
- 6. New PLC's are being supplied, programmed and commissioned under this contract for the monitoring of the new Microwave equipment
- 7. ECWA requested seven additional mGuard routers be supplied for use at various locations
- 8. Additional programming hours have been assigned at ECWA's direction to make enhancements to the system after commissioning; and

WHEREAS, The reasons for the above changes are as follows:

- 1. The Contractor is requesting a 90-day time extension to the Substantial Completion and Final Completion dates due to a) the change directive being issued to the contractor. The information from ECWA was formulated over a longer period of time than expected and additional items were added over time.
- 2. During the development of the distribution SOPs it was determined that a standard template should be developed to provide guidance to the operators on how the distribution system should be operated over a 24 hour period. The template developed and referred to as the "Daily Directive includes a list of the system tanks

- with multiple level setpoints throughout the day. To assist with maintaining the daily directive level setpoints, it was decided to add this list to the SCADA project and automate it along with limiting each tank levels rate of change.
- 3. During the development of the distribution SOPs it was determined that the VFD surge requirement when starting or stopping multiple pumps at a station with VFDs was not included in the contract. Starting an additional pump without slowing down the first pump would increase the system pressure and cause failures.
- 4. During the development of the distribution SOPs it was determined that some sites have process interlocks that were not identified in the contract and are required for operation of the system.
- 5. Guenther pump 1 and 2 require special attention when starting these pumps and ECWA identified that these pumps could be started through the automation of the system. This will allow these pumps to be started without the need to send operators to the site to manual start the pumps.
- 6. To increase the reliability of communications to the remote sites, ECWA has purchased mGuard routers with built in cellular communications capabilities. The mGuard router provides the ability to automatically switch between radio and cellular communications. The cellular communications also provides high data throughout for improved system response time and ability to make changes to the system remotely. To monitor the mGuard router status (cellular failure, Radio failure, router fault) the mGuard router needs to be wired to each site RTU and alarmed on the SCADA system.
- 7. ECWA have requested that the eight existing stations with chlorine monitoring will have the analyzers replaced with a Hach Water Distribution Monitoring Panel (WDMP) unit which will be able to monitor seven parameters. These are chlorine residual, temperature, pressure, PH, TOC, turbidity and conductivity. All seven signals are being added to SCADA with the alarms and trending.
- 8. ECWA have requested that an additional six Hach WDMP units be added to SCADA at various locations for monitoring the water corrosive properties. These locations are to be determined at a later date.
- 9. The new microwave network will have communication shelters located at remote sites and this change order is for the Contractor to provide RTUs to monitor the health of the microwave equipment including temperature, intrusion, utility power status, etc. It also includes adding the alarms to the displays.
- 10. ECWA has requested seven additional mGuard routers so they can place them in various locations.
- 11. This is additional work at ECWA's direction to make enhancements to the system after commissioning; and
