Subject: Gov Spend Software

As mentioned at the June 14, 2018 Board of Commissioners Meeting, we are now aware of a pricing transparency software that will greatly enhance our research toolbox.

This powerful search engine will provide intelligence on pricing and sole source authenticity from over 20,000 local, state and federal agencies.

Gov Spend was presented at the 2018 Gov Buy Conference in Albany, New York. It is strongly supported by two procurement colleagues, Sean Carroll, Chief Procurement Officer at the Office of General Services, and Paul Brennan, Rockland County Purchasing Director and former President of New York State Association of Municipal Purchasing Officials and National Institute of Governmental Purchasing.

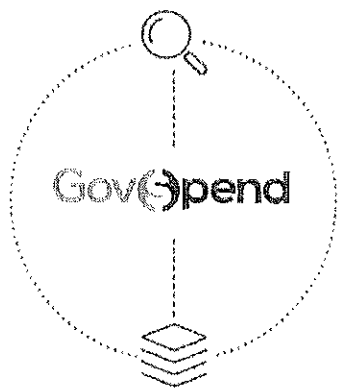
