1.05 QUALITY ASSURANCE

A. General

- 1. The Authority shall be allowed on-site at any time for inspection of the work.
- 2. All parts shall be fabricated to within 0.005" of requested dimensions.
- 3. If the Authority is not satisfied with the work quality and progress, it shall have the right to terminate this Contract at any time upon seven (7) days written notice.

PART 2 - PAYMENT

2.01 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

A. General

- 1. Payment shall be at the hourly rates stipulated in the Contract.
- 2. The hourly rate shall include an amount, considered by the Contractor, adequate to cover the Contractor's labor, tools, equipment, and overhead and profit.
- 3. Overhead and profit can be charged on materials only at a rate not to exceed 10%. The Contractor shall provide copies of material invoices with the bills for the specified project.
- 4. An additional amount may be charged to the hourly rate to cover subcontracted work at a rate not to exceed 10% for any preapproved work.

2.02 CONTRACT DURATION

If the Erie County Water Authority and CONTRACTOR mutually agree to continue this Contract after the 31st day of July 2018, it shall be extended for not more than two 1-year terms on the same terms and conditions provided for herein. CONTRACTOR shall provide written notification to the Erie County Water Authority of the contract extension prior to the expiration of the initial term of this Contract.
